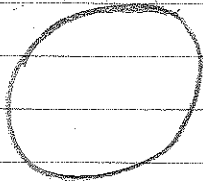


# Circumference and Perimeter

The distance around an object.



Distance around a circle is circumference



Distance around anything else is perimeter

To find perimeter add up the lengths of all sides.

To find circumference use the formula

$$C = 2\pi r \quad \text{or} \quad C = \pi d$$

$r$  = radius (half way across a circle)  
 $d$  = diameter (all the way across a circle)
