

# Unit Price

What is a better deal, 15 for \$22.99 or \$28.99 for 20?

Find out what each piece costs

$$\frac{\$22.99}{15} = \$1.53$$

$$\frac{\$28.99}{20} = \$1.45$$

20 piece is a better deal

Price for 1 is called unit price

Unit Price = $\frac{\$}{\#}$
------------------------------

2L milk for \$3.54

$$\text{unit price} = \frac{\$3.54}{2} = \$1.77 \text{ per L}$$

2 year subscription to monthly magazine for \$48.37

$$\text{unit price} = \frac{\$48.37}{24} = \$2.02 \text{ per issue}$$
