Phytoplankton are tiny plants

Zooplankton are tiny animals that eat other plankton

Wetlands are areas which are somewhat in between lakes and dry land. They are found at the edges of rivers and lakes. Swamps are also wetlands.

An estuary is an area where freshwater and saltwater mix. Nutrients in estuaries come from runoff, as well as the ocean. 80% of wildlife found of the coast of BC uses estuaries.
